



Julietta Winery is reopening June 12, 2020, and we couldn't be more excited.

There will be some new rules and guidelines for everyone to follow as we all get used to this "new normal". The outdoor areas are prepped and ready to welcome you back. We will be open for outdoor, tableside service only. We will be offering wine by the bottle, by the glass, and an option for a flight of wines in lieu of wine tasting. The current guidance requires a separate glass for each sampling of wine.

Here are some of the guidelines:

Per Yolo County's rule, you are required to wear a face mask while you are on the property. You can take off your face mask once you are seated and the wine is served. But, if you get up from your table, you must put your mask back on.

One of the big changes as we get going is reservation service. Reservations are recommended when you come visit us to ensure that we have sufficient seating while providing social distancing. Walk-ins will still be welcome on first-come first-serve and based on available seating.

Groups coming to visit can have a maximum of 6 people. Please remember to socially distance from people who aren't in your party. All children and pets must stay at your table with you at all times.

If you're feeling sick, please avoid visiting the winery.

We know this is different from what we're all used to, but it's all in an effort to keep our visitors and our staff safe.
